Government Gift Aid Scheme & Planned Giving Appeal

If you are a UK tax payer and donate to the church we are able to claim an additional 20% of the amount donated under the Government Gift Aid Scheme. In order for us to do this you must complete a Gift Aid Declaration. Forms are at the back of the church.

If you are a UK tax payer and would like to join the Gift Aid Scheme using cash, please complete sections 1, 2 and 3. Special envelopes will be ordered for you to donate weekly.

If you would like to join the Gift Aid Scheme by standing order please complete sections 1, 2, 3 and 4.

You can also Gift Aid your donation when using the contactless machine. You only have to enter your details to sign up to the Gift Aid Scheme on the machine the first time, each time you use your card it automatically registers that you are a Gift Aider.

If you are not a UK tax payer but would like to donate by standing order please complete sections 1, 2 and 4 only.
